Volunteering with us

This role primarily involves office-based online research, with some phone call work. It is suitable for someone who is confident with using computers, using the internet, and in particular someone who has previously carried out online research and/or worked with spreadsheets and data.

This is a resource that we want to make available to the community and be able to keep updated and relevant. The map is currently imbedded on our Explorers website and we are looking at developing it as a distinctive online resource on our main website and possibly an app.

*The Volunteer Role for mapping is flexible. Ideally the role would best suit someone able to commit (for example) **1 day a week/fortnight over 1-3 months.***

You will experience:

- Working as part of a team to research and develop the social care map.
- Engaging with social care organisations and providers to facilitate the sharing of knowledge and information.
- Assisting with the ongoing online development of the social care map and potential app development.
- Developing research and data management skills
- Developing greater understanding of the networks of support needs for people with complex support needs, and of the importance of advocacy and representation
